County Executive Arts Awards
YOUTH WITH EXCEPTIONAL PROMISE IN THE ARTS

Eligibility

- Dutchess County high school senior, as of September 2005.
- All arts disciplines eligible, including visual, performing, literary, film/video, and computer, among others.

Nomination Process

The nominator should demonstrate the youth's achievement and promise, and evolving commitment to his/her art over time by submitting the following:

- Youth's name, address, and phone number.
- Nominator's name, address, phone number, and email address.
- A brief (1/2 page/500 word maximum) narrative which discusses the youth's artistry - i.e., on what evidence of talent, accomplishment and promise is the nomination based? Also discuss the youth's evolving commitment to his/her art form, i.e., on what evidence of the youth's desire and intention to continue developing in the art form is the nomination based?
- Support materials appropriate to the art form: Up to 5 pieces in a portfolio; up to 5 slides; up to 5 minutes of work on video- or audio-cassette, cd, dvd or film reel; up to 5 double-spaced pages of creative writing demonstrating artistic accomplishment.
- Two written references from professional individuals familiar with the youth's work. Include name of person writing the reference, his/her address, phone number and email address. The nominator may serve as a reference.
